

What is Expected from a Brookwood Official

Brookwood Officials include: Referees, Timers and Scorers

All officials under the age of 18 MUST be registered as a player or volunteer coach/assistant coach in the 2017/2018 season.

All officials are expected:

- To be present at each clinic. **All clinics and meetings are mandatory**. Those failing to attend without a valid reason will not be permitted to work as an official.
- To be punctual
- To be professional on and off the court
- To know the rules pertaining to the job
- To follow the dress code
- Responsible for verifying online each week if assigned any games
- Responsible for notifying minimum 48 hours in advance if unable to make it
- Referees only: Must write 2 exams.

1st exam: beginning of season, to determine level of referee, dependent on the grade. Pass is not required for new referees.

2nd exam: mid season, to re-determine level of referee, dependent on the grade. Pass is required for all referees.

- All officials must write a timing/scoring exam
- All veteran referees will be evaluated on the court, and must pass the evaluation along with the written exam to be allowed to continue refereeing.

Brookwood Basketball complies with FIBA rules. It is highly recommended that all persons interested in becoming an official read the **FIBA rule book** and **two person officiating**.
